This is a wonderful process for practitioners of dance, but also anyone who wants to learn a more expansive way to reciprocate in their work and with their environment. It introduces an ongoing process which will be offered throughout 2011-12, in both studio and bush settings. Zsuzsi has extensive experience working with people with injury or disability.
